The use of film footage, photographs, sound, web sites and related medium for the purpose of commercial venture will be prohibited unless previously arranged with CARP Tournament Series and its affiliated companies. Personal use and news broadcast purposes are allowed.

Representatives of the media are required to demonstrate the utmost respect to the competitors, participants, sponsors, fans, volunteers and staff of the event/tournament.

A schedule of events, including social gatherings, will be made available to the media. Media is welcome and encouraged to attend any event.
